It is also possible to apply for tariff reduction electronically through the website www.altinn.no or the website of the Norwegian Agricultural Agency (NAA), www.landbruksdirektoratet.no. Electronically submitted applications will reach the NAA, and be processed, quicker. The NAA aims to process applications within ten working days.

Guidance

Points 1 to 3 must be filled out by all applicants applying for reduced customs duties. You must submit in one application for each product for which you request tariff reduction.

1. Information about the importer

The importer must fill in these fields. In case of change of address, the NAA must be informed. Any change in address will be checked against the Central Coordinating Register for Legal Entities ("the Register"), and in case of discrepancy, the address registered in the Register will be used. Therefore, in case of change of address, we ask that you also inform the Register. Organisation number refers to the Norwegian organisation number given by the Register.

2. Information about the product

It is the sole responsibility of the importer to submit the correct Norwegian tariff code number. In case of doubt, you must contact the Norwegian Customs Authorities (<http://www.toll.no/en/>). It is necessary to write the full name of the product as stated on the invoice provided by the exporter. There shall be no discrepancy between the product name as written in the application and the name on the invoice.

In the field Country of Origin, you must write the origin of the product in accordance with the product certificate, the certificate of origin or other documentation certifying the product's origin.

THE APPLICATION CONCERNS

The importer must acquaint himself with the rules applicable to the product for which he requests tariff reduction. Applications for reduced customs duties are assessed in accordance with the FAT regulation (forskrift 22. desember 2005 nr. 1723 om administrative tollnedsettelse for landbruksvarer; in English: Regulation no. 1723 of 22nd December 2005 on reduced customs duties for agricultural products).

3a. Reduced customs duties for agricultural products

Applications for reduced customs duties for agricultural products are assessed in accordance with Articles 11 to 14 of FAT. If the product contains ingredients listed in Annex 2 to FAT, or grains or flour of wheat, oat, barley, rye and triticale, these must be specified with their respective percentages of the total product.

Tick the box "organic" if the product is certified organic in accordance with applicable laws (see forskrift 4. oktober 2005 nr. 1103 om økologisk produksjon og merking av økologiske landbruksprodukter og næringsmidler; in English: Regulation no. 1103 of 4th October 2005 concerning organic production and labelling of organic agricultural products and foodstuffs).

Tick the box "preserves" if Articles 18b, 18c or 18d of FAT apply.

3b. Reduced customs duties with declaration of end use

You may apply for tariff reduction for different feed products (finalized feed products or ingredients to feed products) in accordance with paragraphs 1, 3, 4 or 5 of Articles 15 FAT. You may also apply for tariff reduction for a product listed in annex 6 to FAT which will be an ingredient in the production of processed agricultural products (PAPs) in accordance with Article 18 FAT. PAPs are listed in Table 1 to Protocol 3 of the EEA-Agreement. During customs clearance, you must be able to present both the permit for reduced tariff and the declaration of end use. Controls on the right end use of products are carried out regularly.

3c. Reduced customs duties for seeds

Reduced customs duties may be granted for certain seed products to be used in agriculture and lawn/grass. These are published on the website www.landbruksdirektoratet.no.

3d. Tariff reduction for vitamins and minerals to animal feed

Reduced customs duties may be granted for vitamins and minerals that will be added to animal feed, pursuant to FAT Article 15, paragraph 2. The ingredients must be given in percentage of the total product. The sum total of the ingredients must be 100 %. For composite ingredients (composed of more than one ingredient), reduced customs duties may be granted to the part of the product which is composed of vitamins and/or minerals. In such cases, this must be specified in detail.

4. Any additional information

Here, you may write any comments relating to the qualifying criteria for reduced customs duties, or any other information that may be relevant for the case management (such as price information).

5. Documentation requirements for applications for reduced tariffs

You must have all the necessary information about the contents of the product when applying for reduced tariff. This must be procured from the producer of the product. You are obliged to keep this information available in case the Agency asks for it. The NAA may ask for this documentation during random or targeted controls, or in order to process the case. If the documentation does not satisfy the requirements below, the application will be rejected.

Documentation requirements:

- The documentation must clearly show that it emanates from the producer (for example, by logo or stamp).
- All the product's ingredients must be clearly indicated.
- All the ingredients relevant for the calculation of the tariff must be indicated in percentage. These are the agricultural products listed in Annex 2 to FAT, plus grains and flour of wheat, oats, barley, rye and triticale.
- The documentation must be in English or a Scandinavian language (Norwegian, Swedish or Danish)
- The documentation must be updated at the time of application, and must show the product's contents as they are at the time of importation.

6. Signature

The application must be dated. By your signature, you confirm that the information you have provided is correct.
